1. What is one thing that stands out to you about John Knox, the Scottish reformer from Pastor's message on Sunday?
  
2. Read the account of Jesus' crucifixion in Matthew 27:32-54. Answer the following:
  - o In verse 34 they offered him wine "mixed with gall," why did Jesus refuse it? (Notice what was different about the second drink he was offered that he accepted in verse 48).
  
  - o In verse 40 and 42 Jesus is asked by the mockers to "come down from the cross" to prove He was the Son of God. What is ironic about that request?
  
  - o Read verses 45,46 and write down any thoughts concerning the three hours of darkness and what is the importance of Jesus saying "My God My God why have you forsaken Me?"
  
  - o What is the importance of the curtain being ripped from "top to bottom" in verse 51 and what practical implications did that have for the Christian faith?
