A Good Report

1 Thessalonians 1:6-10

1. An idol is anything in your life that takes the place of god. What is something in your life outside of God that gives you meaning a purpose? Or, what is something that, if it were taken from you, would make following God difficult?
2. Pick an example of idolatry in your Bible (example: the golden calf in Ex. 32). What does the passage reveal about God's attitude towards idolatry? What can it mean for you today?
3. In several N.T. passages, Paul encourages believers to follow him and be imitators of Christ in him (1 Thess. 1:6, 1 Cor. 11:1). Who do you know, at Lakeside or elsewhere, that is worthy of imitation? In what areas of your faith does this person challenge you?
