1. Share something God has taught you this summer either from His Word or from a personal experience.

It is found in Proverbs 18:13,15,17. What do these verses teach us?

Please look them up and then write down three principles about your speech that God has impressed upon you. Proverbs 4:24; 6:16-19; 10:19,31-32; 12:18,22; 16:13,24; 17:28; 18:21; 21:23; 25:11,12,28.

4. The Lord's final command to His disciples was for them to be a faithful witness for Him (Matthew 28:19,20). What does that entail?
