1. Read Luke 12:13-21 and write down your thoughts about the difference between how the community would have looked at the farmer and how God looked at the farmer and called him a “fool”:

Meditate upon the teaching of Deuteronomy 8:17,18 *“Beware lest you say in your heart, ‘My power and the might of my hand have gotten me this wealth.’ You shall remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth”* and write down your thoughts about living in light of this truth:
4. What does the statement “Investing in Eternity means Distributing Now” mean to you?
5. How do we move from “acknowledging” that God owns everything and we are His “distributors” to truly and wholeheartedly living like God owns everything and becoming “distributors”?
