## **Sermon Notes and Questions**

- 1) Read Philippians 1:27-2:4 and write down and share a couple of thoughts and truths that stuck out to you.  
  
2) Pastor shared that believers had the unique responsibility to Stand Up and Be Counted for the “faith of the Gospel” (Phil. 1:27-30) as well as Stoop Down and Be Considerate concerning the family of God (2:1-4). Pastor then stated that believers often get these two commands reversed – we often stoop down to this world and its ways and we stand up (not stand for) to fellow believers and their interests. Why is this disastrous to the cause of Christ?  
  
3) Do a Bible study listing at least 10 “one another” passages of Scripture in the New Testament. Pick out two of those and make a commitment to put them into practice this week.
