1.10.21 **Believer's Baptism** Acts 18:5-8



- 1. Our GG's have not met for a number of weeks. Please share a **spiritual blessing** you have experienced over the holiday break.
- 2. Pastor shared Sunday that the method of baptism (immersion) is wrapped up in the meaning of baptism, and you cannot change the method without destroying its meaning. Read Romans 6:1-6 and share any insight from this passage of Scripture about how the method of baptism and the meaning of baptism are tied together.
- 3. Read Acts 18:5-7 and do your own study on this beautiful and concise story of baptism. Answer questions such as: Who is a worshipper of God (7)? What is a "ruler of the synagogue" (8)? What did the "entire household" (8) do? What is the sequence of believer's baptism? What logical order does a person follow who is a biblical candidate for baptism (8)? Record any other observations and be ready to share!

4. Share your thoughts from the baptism service on Sunday. Is there a testimony that stood out to you? How long has it been since you shared your salvation story verbally with someone?
