## Believer's Baptism

Acts 18:5-8



1. Our GG's have not met for a number of weeks. Please share a **spiritual blessing** you have experienced over the holiday break.
2. Pastor shared Sunday that the method of baptism (immersion) is wrapped up in the meaning of baptism, and you cannot change the method without destroying its meaning. Read Romans 6:1-6 and share any insight from this passage of Scripture about how the method of baptism and the meaning of baptism are tied together.
3. Read Acts 18:5-7 and do your own study on this beautiful and concise story of baptism. Answer questions such as: Who is a worshipper of God (7)? What is a "ruler of the synagogue" (8)? What did the "entire household" (8) do? What is the sequence of believer's baptism? – What logical order does a person follow who is a biblical candidate for baptism (8)? Record any other observations and be ready to share!
4. Share your thoughts from the baptism service on Sunday. Is there a testimony that stood out to you? How long has it been since you shared your salvation story verbally with someone?
