## **A Legacy of Sacrifice**

### **Psalm 51**



1. Psalm 51 is a prayer. Pray together as a Growth Group asking God to give each of you a broken spirit and a contrite heart. Pray also that He would grant honesty and receptivity to the rebuke of sin in your lives. Pray then for Lakeside Fellowship that we would be able to pass on the sacrifices of a broken spirit and a contrite heart to generations to come.
2. Read Psalm 51 and share what stands out to you the most.
3. How should the fact that every sin is to be understood as an act of rebellion against God affect our attitude towards sin? Many of us struggle to see sin in such serious terms. We often become indifferent or apathetic about it. Why is that? How do we change that?
4. David asks for cleansing that he might help others who are struggling so that he can praise God. How has God used others in your life to help you in your struggles with sin? How has God used your struggles to help others?
5. What are some things that we can do this week to replicate a broken and contrite heart in others around us?

Communication Card Next Steps: Memorize Psalm 51:17

I will take sin seriously in my life this week by being broken over it, confessing it to God, and then rejoicing that because of Christ, my sin is blotted out.
