Psalm 78:1-8



1. Read all of Psalm 78 and record the various ways God responds when the Israelites sin against Him. What stands out to you most about God's response?

2. According to Psalm 78:4, what would the Psalmist want us to teach our children and our children's children? If you were to take this admonition and responsibility to heart – what are the glorious deeds of the Lord, what is His might, and what are the wonders He has done that we must tell the next generation based on your personal relationship and experience with God through Christ? What are the most important things you would want to pass along to your children or grandchildren (be specific and not just generalities)?

3. What is the parent's role in the spiritual formation of a child? What is the local church's role in the spiritual formation of a child? What is the grandparent's role in the spiritual formation of a child?

4. Everyone has a spiritual next step – share yours with your GG so that they can pray for you, encourage you, and hold you accountable!
