John 2:23-3:12



1. Read John 2:23-3:12. How is Nicodemus (3:1-12) a perfect example of what Jesus says He knows in John 2:23-25?
2. Jesus tells Nicodemus he must be “born again” in John 3:3,7. Peter also uses this phrase in I Peter 1:3 and 1:23. Explain what being “born again” involves and what are the blessings of being “born again”?
3. Why was it such a blow to Nicodemus to be told by Jesus he must be “born again”? Discuss why it is that religious people often struggle with being born again?
4. Was Nicodemus “born again” (John 3:1-12; 7:50-52; 19:39-40)? What can we learn from Nicodemus?
5. If you are truly born again, write out your salvation story (one sided piece of paper if possible) and bring it to GG to share with your group:
