I Kings 18:20-40



1. Elijah's prayer was that God would make Himself known as the One True God. How has God made Himself known to you in the past? How can you integrate Elijah's prayer into your daily prayer life? Example: Pray that God would make Himself known to the North Polk community through Lakeside VBS.

2. Read Matthew 6:19-34 and Matthew 12:22-30. What principles from this passage could be related to the idolatry that was taking place in Israel during the time of Elijah?

3. Elijah offers a sacrifice that day, and God sends fire to accept the sacrifice and show that He is the One True God. Read Hebrews 9:23-10:14 and write down how Christ's sacrifice is superior to the animal sacrifices in the Old Testament.
