## **Powerful Prayer**

I Kings 18:41-46



1. Study the following passages this week and write down your observations about prayer: Romans 8:26; Hebrews 4:14-16; Philippians 4:5-7; Matthew 6:5-13 (The Lord's Prayer); John 17 (Jesus praying for the disciples and for the church)
  
2. Write down specific promises that we have from God, then integrate them into your prayer life by thanking God for them as you pray. (Example: God is always with us, therefore pray thanking God that He is with a brother and sister as they walk through a trial. Pray that God would make His presence known to them.)
  
3. Read one of Paul's prayers in Philippians 1:3-10, then take time to use verses 9 and 10 specifically to pray for someone. Pray the Word!

Connection Card Next Steps: Memorize Hebrews 4:16
