Elijah's Homegoing

II Kings 2:1-18



1. Read Joshua 4, which is about the people of Israel under the leadership of Joshua crossing the Jordan River into the Promised Land. Record what God had the people do as they crossed and when they camped at Gilgal. How do you and your family remember God's faithfulness?

2. Pastor Joel talked about how we are designed and destined for eternity. God was not done with Elijah when He brought him to heaven. Read the accounts of Jesus transfiguration in Matthew 17:1-8, Mark 9:2-8, and Luke 9:28-36. Write down what Elijah was doing as he appeared with Jesus and Moses. Read and study Revelation 11:1-14. What was Elijah's role in this passage?

3. Read Colossians 3:1-17, Paul tells us in verse 2 to "Set our minds on things above, not on things that are on the earth." Write down what we are to put to death and then write down what we are to put on in order to set our minds on things above.
