John 7:53-8:11



1. Jesus told the woman in John 8:11, “Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on, sin no more (leave your life of sin).” Take time to read Romans 6, 7, and 8. Write down any observations that you see in these three chapters that expound on what Jesus was telling the woman.

2. Meditate on the fact that we are just like the woman caught in adultery and through Jesus dying on the cross for us, we have been set free from sin, and there is now no condemnation. What priorities and motives need to change this week to reflect that reality?
