John 8:39-59



1. Using John 8:39-59 and I John 5, write down every difference of the one who is a child of the Father and the one who is a child of the devil?

2. Let's study what made Abraham such an important person in Scripture:
 - What promises did God make to Abraham in Genesis 12:1-3 (called the Abrahamic Covenant)?
 - How did Abraham respond to the promises of God (Genesis 12:4)?
 - Look closely at Genesis 12:1 and write down the steps of faith God was asking Abraham to take:
 - Notice God told Abraham to go to a land He would "show you" (Genesis 12:1) and that Abraham simply obeyed "so Abraham went" (Genesis 12:4). When Abram first took off, did he know where he was going according to these couple of verses? (Look up Hebrews 11:8-12). What does that say about Abram's faith in God?
 - What promise did God make to Abram in Genesis 15:1-5 and how did Abram respond in Genesis 15:6?
 - What does it mean that God "counted it to him as righteousness?" (Look up Romans 4:1-6; Galatians 3:6-14)
 - Pastor mentioned in his sermon that to do the deeds of Abraham (John 8:39) meant two things. What were they (8:42,47)?
