Matthew 16:13-25



1. What are some misperceptions of Jesus that you've heard from people? How has your perception of Jesus changed over time?
2. If you and your unsaved neighbor face the exact same hardship this year, how would standing on the rock of the Gospel make you respond differently?
3. What is the hardest command of Jesus for you to follow? (Think about loving your enemies, forgiving those who offend you, focusing on treasures in Heaven, etc.)
4. If you knew Jesus was going to walk beside you every day this week, how would you change your behavior?
5. What could you do this year to walk more closely with Jesus and understand Him better?

Connection Card Next Steps: Matthew 16:24-25

This week, I will have this conversation with one person: "We talked this weekend at church about different perceptions of Jesus. Who do *you* think He is?"

I will read Matthew 5-7 (The Sermon on the Mount) and identify one commandment of Jesus that I should be obeying more faithfully if I am truly following Him.
