## Like Father, Like Son

Exodus 33:18-34:9



1. Read Exodus 33:18-34:9 and list all adjectives/attributes that God used to describe Himself. Which ones are most personal and most important to you? Why?
2. Exodus 34:6-7 are quoted dozens of times in the Bible. Look up the following verses and study the context that these attributes of God are used and why:
  - Lamentations 3:22-23
  - Numbers 14:13-19
  - Psalm 86
  - Jonah 4
3. Jesus said, “If you have seen Me, you have seen the Father” (John 14:9). John 1:14 says, “the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.” Use the list of attributes from Exodus 34:6-7 and write down a specific instance where Jesus exhibited and lived out each of these attributes. For example, God is merciful/compassionate (Exodus 34:6) – Jesus “looked on the crowds and had compassion on them” (Matthew 9:36). If you cannot find the reference, then just list the situation/event that corresponds:
4. What can you personally apply to your life from this study in Exodus 33:18-34:9 entitled *The Heart of Christ: Like Father, Like Son*? What does God want or deserve from you? What is God asking of you as a personal response?
