1. Read Luke 15:1-7 again. Write down what stood out to you from this passage and the sermon this past Sunday:
2. Read the rest of Luke 15, verses $8-32$. As you read, focus on the actions of the woman who lost the coin and the father of the prodigal son. Write down the actions and how Jesus acts the same way towards sinners:
3. Read II Corinthians $5: 11-21$. Notice the ministry we have been given (v. 18) and what compels us to fulfill this ministry (v.14). How can you be active in the ministry of reconciliation?
4. We are halfway through our mini-series on The Heart of Christ. Take some time to pray this week. Ask God to continue to give you a greater understanding of His heart and to change your heart to be more like His.
