1. There is a special blessing given in Revelation 1:3 – please note what the blessing is and spend a minute or two pondering why this special blessing for the book of Revelation?

2. Read Revelation 1 and write down every word or phrase that describes the Lord Jesus (over 20 words, phrases):

3. Write down the names of the 7 churches Jesus mentions by name in Revelation 1:9-11 and look up in a Bible map where they were located (you can Google the “7 churches of Revelation” map). We will be studying each church over the summer months so become acquainted with them.

4. Picture in your mind the scene described in Revelation 1:12-20:
 - Verse 12 speaks of the 7 golden lampstands – verse 20 gives the answer to what they represent (write it down).
 - Verse 13 speaks of the “son of man” standing in the middle. Who is the “son of man”? Look up Daniel 7:13-14, Matthew 8:20, Matthew 12:40, Matthew 24:44, and Acts 7:56.
 - Verses 14, 15, and 16 describe the “son of man” – write down your thoughts:
 - Verse 17 describes John’s reaction – similar to how Abraham, Moses, Balaam, Joshua, Gideon, and Isaiah when they came into the presence of God

5. Spend some time on your knees, in a quiet spot reflecting on the truths and the scene of Revelation 1 and speak to God asking Him for wisdom and discernment for this summer study in Revelation 1-3:
