1. Read Leviticus 25:25, Deuteronomy 25:5-10, and Ruth 2:20 where the theme/idea of the kinsman redeemer is referenced. (For extra credit, read Ruth 3 and 4 to see the idea of kinsman redeemer played out). Pastor listed 6 things a kinsman redeemer was required to do for a near relative as a kinsman. List the 6 things:

- 2. Boaz is a **picture of Jesus**, the ultimate kinsman redeemer!
 - In what ways is Boaz a picture of Christ? (Pastor listed them in his sermon.)
 - In the book of Ruth, Naomi and Ruth needed to be redeemed. How gracious for God to provide Boaz to redeem them! In life, sinners need to be redeemed how gracious of God to provide His Son as the ultimate kinsman redeemer! Look up the following Scriptures about Jesus redeeming lost sinners:
 - o Romans 3:21-25a
 - o Galatians 3:13-14
 - o I Peter 1:18-19
 - Pastor mentioned 4 things that were necessary to be qualified to be a redeemer. How did Jesus qualify to be a perfect redeemer?
 - If you are a follower of Christ, He is your kinsman redeemer. What should this motivate or compel you to be and do?
