A Picture of Christ

Ruth 2:14-23



1. Read Leviticus 25:25, Deuteronomy 25:5-10, and Ruth 2:20 where the theme/idea of the kinsman redeemer is referenced. (For extra credit, read Ruth 3 and 4 to see the idea of kinsman redeemer played out). Pastor listed 6 things a kinsman redeemer was required to do for a near relative as a kinsman. List the 6 things:

2. Boaz is a **picture of Jesus**, the ultimate kinsman redeemer!
 - In what ways is Boaz a picture of Christ? (Pastor listed them in his sermon.)
 - In the book of Ruth, Naomi and Ruth needed to be redeemed. How gracious for God to provide Boaz to redeem them! In life, sinners need to be redeemed - how gracious of God to provide His Son as the ultimate kinsman redeemer! Look up the following Scriptures about Jesus redeeming lost sinners:
 - Romans 3:21-25a
 - Galatians 3:13-14
 - I Peter 1:18-19
 - Pastor mentioned 4 things that were necessary to be qualified to be a redeemer. How did Jesus qualify to be a perfect redeemer?
 - If you are a follower of Christ, He is your kinsman redeemer. What should this motivate or compel you to be and do?
