Worthy Is the Lamb

Revelation 5:5-14



1. Last week Pastor mentioned principles of worship from Mary of Bethany from Matthew 26:6-16. Meditate upon that passage of Scripture and write down personal thoughts about what needs to happen in your life for real worship to take place:
 - Worship is a verb – not something watched, listened to, or attended.
 - Worship is about a specific person, not a specific place.
 - Worship is less about our lips and more about our lives – Mary did not speak one single word in all 3 Gospel accounts.
 - Worship encompasses all of life, not just a slice of life.
 - Worship is about getting low before God before you get high on God.
 - Worship is about giving not getting.
 - a) Offering worth to Christ, ascribing worth
 - b) Offering my best, not leftovers
 - c) 1st mention of worship (Abraham – Genesis 22:5)
 - d) Moses – Hebrews 11:24-26
 - e) Macedonians – 2 Corinthians 8:1-3 then Philippians 4:18-19

2. For extra credit: Re-read Revelation 5:1-14 and write down any thoughts concerning worship, such as who is worshipped, who is worshipping, and what is the new song.
