Connection Card Next Steps -

***I will** read/pray through the first 3 chapters of Genesis (one chapter/day), giving thanks for each attribute and quality of God that Scripture reveals along the way.

*I commit to reading the Book of Genesis by the end of March.



- 1) Read and meditate upon 2 Timothy 2:15 and 2 Timothy 3:16-17.
 - What is the importance of reading Scripture for yourselves?
 - What value does the Scriptures bring to your life?
- 2) Pastor mentioned that Genesis should be studied comparatively that is comparing Scripture with Scripture to find the proper meaning of a passage of Scripture.
 - Read Acts 17:11 Why were the Bereans "more noble?"
 - Read Genesis 1 and notice that God's Word says God created in 6 literal days (1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31) and then rested on the 7th day (2:1-3). The majority of the world does not believe that God is the Creator, and even fewer believe He created in 6 literal days. So, compare what God's Word says in Genesis 1-2 with what God said in Exodus 20:8-11. How does Exodus 20:8-11 help us conclude that God created the world in 6 literal days?
- 3) Pastor mentioned that the Book of Genesis should be studied Christocentrically that is, the Book of Genesis should be studied with a view toward seeing the Messiah, the Christ, none other than Jesus Himself. Look up the following passages where Jesus talks about this very truth:
 - John 5:39-47
 - Luke 24:25-27; 44-49
- 4) Extra Credit! Where are some specific places where Jesus is present or foreshadowed in the OT?
 - Who motivated Moses to leave the comforts of Pharoah's palace? Hebrews 11:24-27
 - Read Exodus 12:1-13 and compare that to John 1:29-34.
 - Read Isaiah 53:3-7 and compare that to Matthew 8:17; 9:12; Acts 8:32-35.
 - 1 Corinthians 10:1-5
 - Others?
