Connection Card Next Steps -

***Step 1 - I will talk honestly with God about a trial** I'm facing and ask Him to strengthen my faith through it.

***Step 2 - I will read Psalm 143 as a prayer to God,** celebrating His faithfulness and declaring my dependence on Him.



- The sermon discussed how God uses hard situations to build our faith and to show how much it's grown. What are situations where you've seen your faith grow or situations that surprised you by revealing how much faith you actually have?

- The sacrifice of Isaac points to the true Lamb: Jesus Christ. Read Rev. 5:6-13. List the things that Jesus accomplished as the Lamb who was slain. When you read about the praise for the Lamb in Heaven, what ideas does it give you for worshipping Jesus in THIS life?

- Read Heb. 11:17-18. God delivered the promised son, yet Abraham was willing to give up that promised son when God asked him to. What has God given you that you may need to hold less tightly in order to serve God better? (Think about kids, jobs, houses, money, hobbies, etc.)

- In this passage, Abraham calls God Jehovah Jireh, meaning "The Lord Will Provide" or "The Lord, My Provider." What are situations where you've seen God provide for you? What are situations right now where you need to trust in His provision?
