Connection Card Next Steps -

***Step 1 - I commit to sharing stories** this week of God's faithfulness in my own life for the benefit of those who need encouragement, even when it requires vulnerability. (Deut. 6:6-9)

1. Read Deut. 6:4-9. God instructs the Israelites in how they should be remembering him, instructing their children about his words, and writing his words on their hearts. What are some ways you currently do these things well? How would you like to grow in one or more of these areas over the next days/weeks/months? Are you willing to seek accountability to grow in this area?

2. Share some ways that God has proven His faithfulness to you in your own life. Think about times when you were struggling but remembered how God had worked in your life previously. What was the impact of remembering His faithfulness on your struggles later on? Do you believe it's worth having vulnerability about your own life if you can encourage others? How can you seek opportunities to share God's faithfulness in your own life for the benefit of those around you?

3. Isaac trusted God to provide for his family during a famine, but failed to trust God for protection when he was dwelling in foreign lands. Similar to question 2, what are some ways you are trusting God well? What are some ways you need to grow in trusting God more completely?

4. Notice the parallels between the blessings that Isaac received and the blessing we receive in Jesus Christ. How often do you thank God for all the ways that He has blessed you? Take some time now to do just that. Remember how God has blessed you in big ways, but also in the small, seemingly insignificant ways. Praise Him for His goodness and faithfulness!
